TRAVELLING BETWEEN PLACES AND INHABITANTS

Along the road of the poet Dino Campana - by train and bicycle.



FORMA DEL VIAGGIO: **TORNARE VIAGGIATORI**¹

A first encounter with the poetry of Dino Campana is in Marradi, his birthplace and a Romagna Apennine village within the borders of Tuscany. Marradi and its mountains were a great source of inspiration for his works.



*"Follow a tired wing along the slope
Valley beats and turns: desolate
Visiting the valleys, from which blue
Serenity, from the rugged rocks as
A Village in gray and various towers
At the thought appears and disappears alternately,
Over the barren dream, serenade!"*

The first part of this trip is a short journey by train. We take the bikes on the historic Faentina Railway line to Crespino del Lamone. From here we cycle down to Marradi to the Study Centre of Campana. With help from an expert guide we walk along the route of "6 Lecterns" through Marradi to meet Dino Campana's poetry following the rhythm of our path. There will be lunch in a restaurant and then we will cycle along the road next to the River Lamone passing through Pieve del Tho, finishing at the Via degli Asini at Brisighella, where we end our trip.

Day 1:

Arrive at the B & B Eremo del Lupo in the Regional Park of the Vena del Gesso Romagnola in Brisighella. Dinner. After dinner we will check the bikes thoroughly ensuring they are in good working order and the breaks are working perfectly! Bed.

Day 2:

After a hearty breakfast, we make our way to Brisighella station, buy a ticket and leave the car in the station car park. We take the train and after 25 minutes we will arrive at Crespino del Lamone.

Here we will take the bikes off

the train, stop briefly for a coffee, then put on our jackets and helmets ready to cycle. We start by cycling downhill along the Lamone River. We can stop along the river at Saltacavallo to refresh ourselves in the pools and small waterfalls. When we are ready to leave, we have an easy cycle to Biforco and then on to Marradi. Here we will stop to visit the Study Centre of Campana accompanied by the President of the Mirna Center. At the Center there are many historical documents and a room with interesting works by artists depicting Dino Campana's poetry that have been donated to the Center as a reminder of his work. We can then follow an interesting route around Marradi bringing to life the places Dino Campana describes in his poems. Gianni Cennacchi says "You can't really know the works of Dino Campana without sharing this experience - it is fundamental to your better understanding"



The tour is called "Places and routes of Dino Campana" and is composed of "6 Lecterns" that, thanks to the hard work of volunteers of the Study Centre of Campana, have been erected by the Comune of Marradi. At the "Lecterns" there are explanations, photos, some of the poems that refer to memories, to the landscape, elements of nature and the urban landscapes that Dino Campana spoke of in his work "Canti Orfici" (Orphic songs).

If you are fit enough, you can cycle 8 km up to Campigno where, in front of the church, you can see the white 'shores' and countryside revealing the beauty sung by Campana in his travels to Verna.

The tour ends here and we cycle along the Lamone River, through the forest, going downhill to Pieve del Tho with its splendid Romanesque church to Brisighella, a village bound to its old traditions of Romagna. At the Via degli Asini you can climb up to the Clock Tower, which is on the top of one of the three distinguishing hills of Brisighella. From here you can see the other two hills with the Church of the Madonna of Monticino and The Castle as well as take in the panoramic views of Brisighella and the lush green valley all around. To finish the long day, we can have dinner in a local restaurant or return home.
